

Blue Passionflower (*Passiflora caerulea*)

Grows quickly and smothers other plants. The leaves and unripe fruit are poisonous and can cause nausea and vomiting in humans and animals.

The attached link provides technical information re. this serious weed: Profile, Control, and Biosecurity. Chemical control is probably the most relevant for you.

You will need gloves and long sleeves to prevent contact with the chemical.

Locally Mitre 10 sells: **Yates Zero Glyphosate 490g/L Concentrate**, 200ml, \$16.70. **Do not leave cut stems in contact with soil as they can sprout roots and regrow..**
